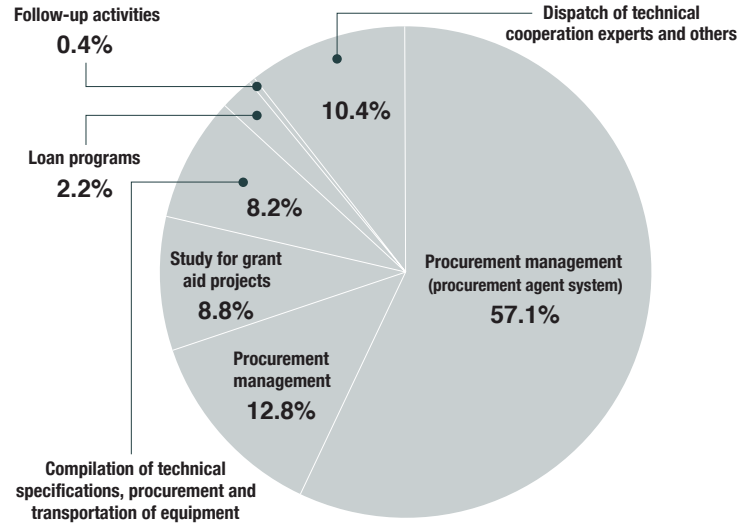

### [Procurement management]

Through contracts with the counterpart country's government, JICS manages and supervises the overall tendering process for procuring equipment and services in connection with grant aid. In some cases, JICS supports the counterpart country's government, which implements projects, while in others it acts as the counterpart country's agent, handling all duties, from managing grant aid funds provided to making contracts with equipment suppliers. The latter system is referred to as the procurement agent system and is used for non-project grant aid, emergency grant aid, and grant aid for conflict prevention and peacebuilding.
