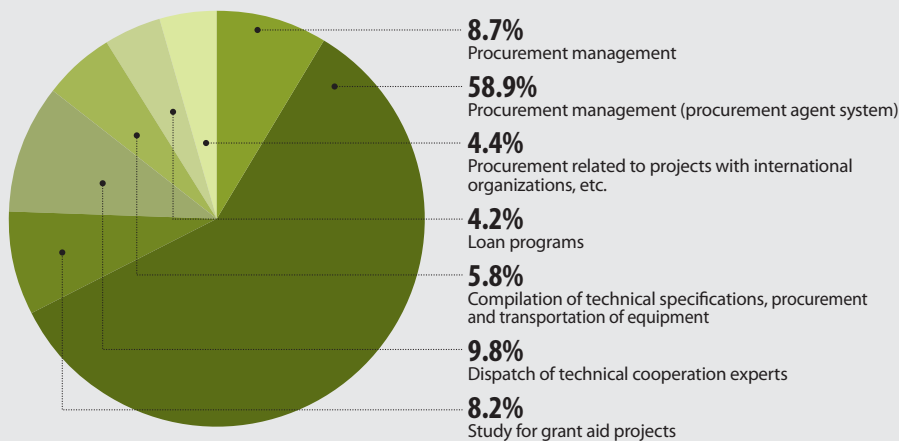


Revenue by Function (FY2007)

The charts below show JICS revenue by function based on work content.

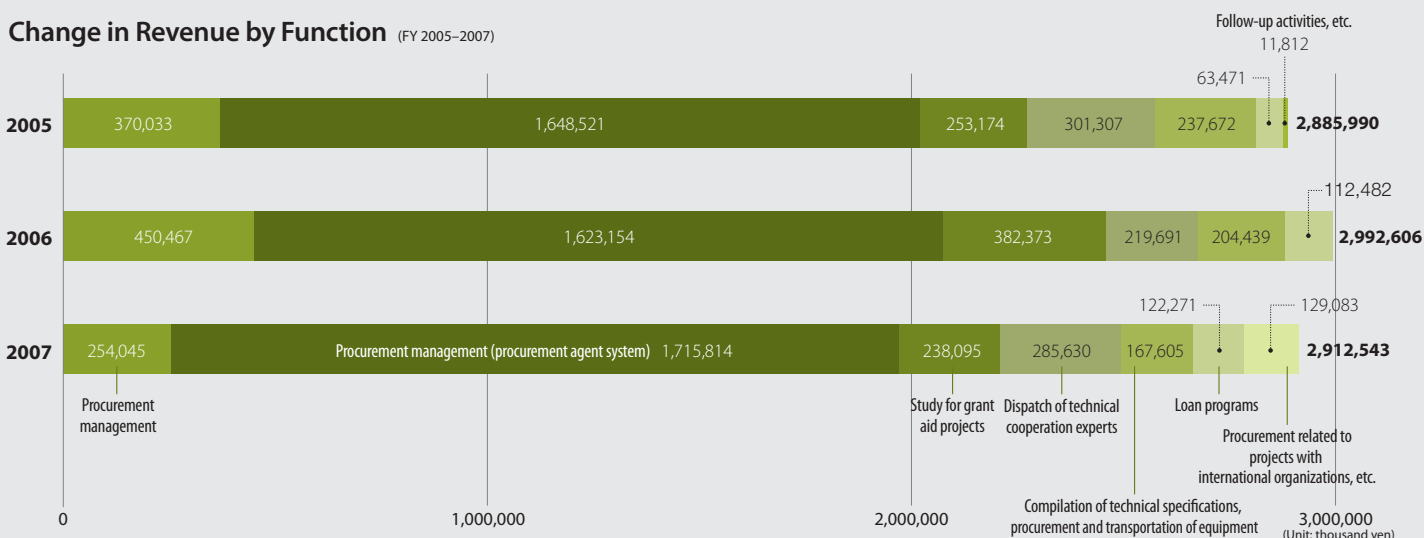

[Procurement management]

Through contracts with the counterpart country's government, JICS as a procurement management agent, manages and supervises the overall process for procuring equipment and selecting services in connection with grant aid (preparing bidding documents, holding bidding sessions, expediting the signing of procurement contracts, and manufacture, transport and delivery of equipment by contractors). This system, in which JICS supports the counterpart country's government implementing projects, is referred to as the procurement management system and is adopted for grant aid for infectious diseases prevention and treatment, grant aid for research and food aid (until the first half of FY2007). Revenue from tender assistance work for cultural grant aid is also included in this item for convenience's sake.

[Procurement management (procurement agent system)]

Through contracts with mainly the counterpart country's government, JICS acts as a procurement agent to manage and supervise the overall process for procuring equipment in connection with grant aid and holding bidding sessions for selecting services. This system is referred to as the procurement agent system because JICS conducts procurement management as an agent of the counterpart country's government implementing projects; it is adopted for food aid (from the second half of FY2007), grant assistance for underprivileged farmers, non-project grant aid, emergency grant aid, grant aid for conflict prevention and peacebuilding, grant aid for community empowerment, and grant aid for disaster prevention and reconstruction.

[Study for grant aid projects]

Through contracts with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, JICA, and other bodies, JICS analyzes the content requested by the counterpart country's government and others to the Japanese government, examining it for appropriateness and evaluating specifications and equipment costs. JICS is involved in studies for grant assistance for underprivileged farmers, cultural grant aid, grant aid for Japanese NGO projects, etc.

[Compilation of technical specifications, procurement and transportation of equipment]

Through contracts with JICA, JICS supports procedures for compiling technical specifications, researching the cost, procurement and transportation of equipment to be provided to the counterpart country's government in connection with the implementation of technical cooperation.

[Loan programs]

Through contracts with JBIC, JICS carries out basic verification of procurement-related documents submitted by the counterpart country's government to confirm that they meet JBIC guidelines and other rules.
