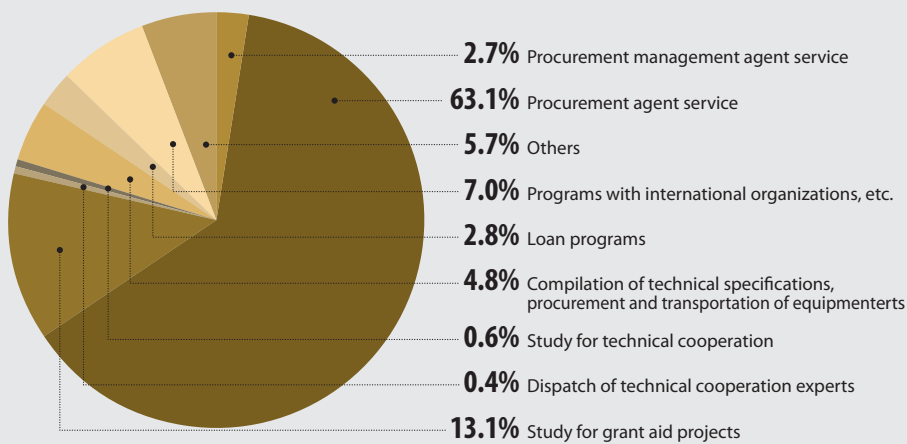


## Revenue by Function (FY2008)

The charts below show JICS revenue by function based on work content (excluding miscellaneous revenues).

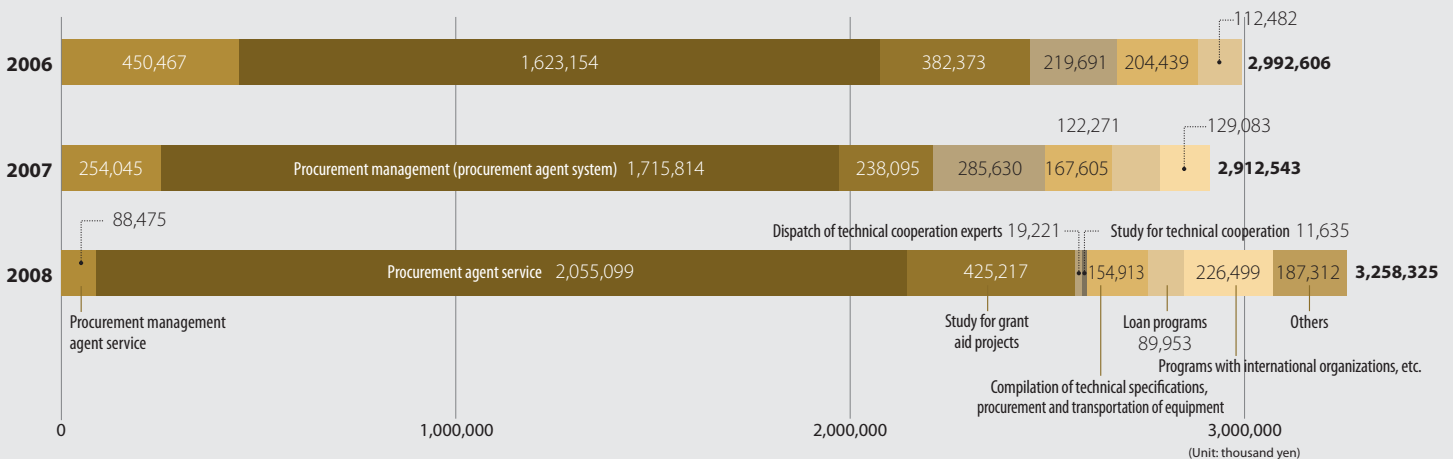

### [Procurement management agent service]

Through contracts with the counterpart country's government, JICS manages and supervises the overall process for procuring equipment and selecting services in connection with grant aid (preparing bidding documents, holding bidding sessions, expediting the signing of procurement contracts, and manufacture, transport and delivery of equipment by contractors). This system, in which JICS supports the counterpart country's government implementing projects, is adopted for grant aid for infectious diseases prevention and treatment and grant aid for research. Revenue from tender assistance work for cultural grant aid is also included in this item for convenience's sake.

### [Procurement agent service]

Through contracts mainly with the counterpart country's government, JICS acts as an agent to manage and supervise the overall process for procuring equipment in connection with grant aid and holding bidding sessions for selecting services. This system, in which JICS conducts procurement management as an agent of the counterpart country's government implementing projects, is adopted for food aid, grant assistance for underprivileged farmers, non-project grant aid, emergency grant aid, grant aid for conflict prevention and peacebuilding, grant aid for community empowerment, grant aid for disaster prevention and reconstruction, and environment program grant aid.

### [Study for grant aid projects]

Through contracts with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, JICA, and other bodies, JICS analyzes the content requested by the counterpart country's government and others to the Japanese government, examining it for appropriateness and evaluating equipment specifications and costs (grant assistance for underprivileged farmers, cultural grant aid).

In addition to above, regarding JICA's grant aid projects, JICS provides technical guidance and advice about basic design study consultants conduct and operating costs they estimate.

### [Dispatch of technical cooperation experts]

Through contracts with JICA, JICS dispatches technical cooperation experts.

### [Study for technical cooperation]

Through contracts with JICA, JICS conducts on-site verification of requested equipment for projects for providing special equipment for infectious diseases prevention and treatment, etc., preparation for procurement and transportation procedures and creation of a database of equipment provision.

### [Compilation of technical specifications, procurement and transportation of equipment]

Through contracts with JICA, JICS supports procedures for providing information, compiling technical specifications, researching the cost, procurement and transportation of equipment to be provided to the counterpart country's government in connection with the implementation of technical cooperation. JICS also dispatches personnel to JICA overseas offices to support local procurement.

### [Loan programs]

Through contracts with JICA (with JBIC before October 2008), JICS carries out basic verification of procurement-related documents submitted by the counterpart country's government to confirm that they meet relevant guidelines and rules.

In addition to above, JICS dispatches instructors for local procurement seminars for yen loan borrowing countries and conducts study for smooth implementation of yen loan programs to achieve their goals.

### [Programs with international organizations, etc.]

JICS conducts studies, procurement management and implementation management services for projects of international organizations, etc. in accordance with their requests.
