

## Using JICS' NGO Support Program to Contribute to the Expansion of International Cooperation Activities by Private Organizations

### ► Summary of NGO Support Program and Selection of Groups to Support in Fiscal 2017

JICS provides funding to assist small and medium-sized Japanese NGOs and NPOs (hereafter, collectively referred to as "NGOs") that assist developing countries. This program involves providing up to ¥1 million or ¥1.6 million per organization to between 7 and 10 organizations per year following the framework shown in the figure on the right. JICS has provided a total of ¥177 million in assistance (to a total of 209 organizations) between 1999 and 2017.

In fiscal 2017, JICS received applications from 22 organizations, and the Selection Committee chose to support 9. JICS holds a conference for NGOs to report on their activities and share ides after its support program. The event provides an opportunity for NGOs to network with other NGOs and share opinions with outside experts.
