PROCUREMENT OF THE PRODUCTS AND/OR SERVICES
UNDER THE SECURITY CAPACITIES ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME
FOR MALAYSIA FY2025
“OFFICIAL SECURITY ASSISTANCE (OSA)”

The Government of Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as “the Recipient”) has received a grant of three billion one hundred million Japanese Yen (JPY3,100,000,000) from the Government of Japan according to the Exchange of Notes between the Governments on October 22, 2025, concerning the Security Capacities Enhancement Programme FY2025 (OSA) (hereinafter referred to as “the Programme”), aiming for ensuring peace, stability and security based on the rule of law, humanitarian activities and/or international peace cooperation activities by the Recipient.

Japan International Cooperation System (JICS), as the procurement agent for and on behalf of the Government of Malaysia, will conduct the procurement of products and/or services through tendering.

JICS thus announces procurement exercises as follows:

1. Products and /or Services to be procured (subject to change)

(1) Products

Diving Support Vessel

The eligible source country of the Products shall be Japan unless otherwise specified in the Tender Documents.

(2) Services

- 1) Procurement of the Products;
- 2) Installation and Set-up Service;
- 3) Operation and Maintenance Training Service; and
- 4) Defect Liability Inspection

2. Eligibility

(1) Companies must meet all of the following criteria:

1) Japanese nationals

- Companies shall be Japanese nationals (Japanese natural persons or juridical persons controlled by Japanese natural persons).
- Companies shall be Japanese companies incorporated and registered under Japanese laws and regulations with their headquarters in Japan.
- The majority of companies’ capital with voting rights shall be owned by Japanese nationals and majority of board members are Japanese natural persons.
- Companies shall not fall under any of the items of Article 26, paragraph 1 of the Foreign

Exchange and Foreign Trade Act (Gaikokukawase-oyobi-Gaikokuboeki-Ho, Act No.228 of 1949, Japan).

2) Financial Capabilities

- Companies shall have full paid-in capital of one (1) billion Japanese yen or more.
- Companies shall have at least three (3) fiscal years' business and to be able to submit Financial Statements (Balance Sheets and Income Statements) of the tenderer's head office for the latest three (3) fiscal years.

3) Companies shall have a branch office, a liaison office or an agent in the recipient country.

4) Companies must have three (3) or more track records in the last ten (10) years as a prime contractor of supplying any products to any central ministries and/or agencies of the Government of Japan.

5) Companies shall not be under the measures of the Government of Japan and the Japan International Cooperation Agency.

6) Companies shall not be suspended from participating in tenders by the Government of Japan, the Japan International Cooperation Agency, or the Recipient.

7) Companies shall not be suspended from participating in tenders in accordance with "DEBARMENT GUIDELINES" set forth by JICS, revised on November 6, 2023, which is posted in JICS's website (https://www.jics.or.jp/jics_html-e/tender/debarment.html)

(2) Neither joint venture nor consortium is allowed.

(3) Additional eligibilities may be required for each procurement.

3. Registration (Prequalification)

(1) It is a prerequisite for all companies wishing to participate in the opportunities to register for prequalification by sending Registration Form ([click here to download](#)) in password-protected PDF format to JICS by e-mail at **osa@jics.or.jp** on or before 5:00 p.m. of September 7, 2026 (Japan Standard Time).

The e-mail should be marked in the subject as follows:

OSA-MY25-002/Registration/Company Name (to be specified)

It is the companies' responsibilities to contact JICS by telephone or e-mail to confirm that JICS is in receipt of their registration documents.

Companies who submit Registration Form are requested to respond to inquiries by JICS about the submitted documents.

(2) By return, JICS will send by e-mail the Application Form to the company which submitted the Registration Form and is deemed appropriate to an applicant. For the applicants' reference, JICS will also send the Form of the agreement on information management to be signed by a prequalified applicant.

(3) JICS will notify the companies in writing of the prequalification result within two (2) weeks after the deadline for the submission of the application documents, 5:00 p.m. of September 10, 2026 (Japan Standard Time).

All the prequalified companies are required to sign the said agreement within one (1) week after the issuance of the prequalification result notice.

(4) Invitations for tender for the procurement of the Products and/or the Services mentioned in 1. above will be issued in due time to the prequalified companies who signed the agreement. Such

invitation will be sent by e-mail at once to the prequalified companies.
