#### Local Economic / Social Issues

In India, due to economic and institutional constraints, the breast cancer screening system is not sufficiently developed and the importance of early detection is not well recognized, resulting in the severity and mortality of breast cancer patients being extremely high.

#### **Details of Demonstration**

We will conduct a demonstration of the effectiveness of breast cancer self-palpation assistive gloves with DX technology to perform a comparative analysis with breast cancer palpation tests performed with bare hands.
