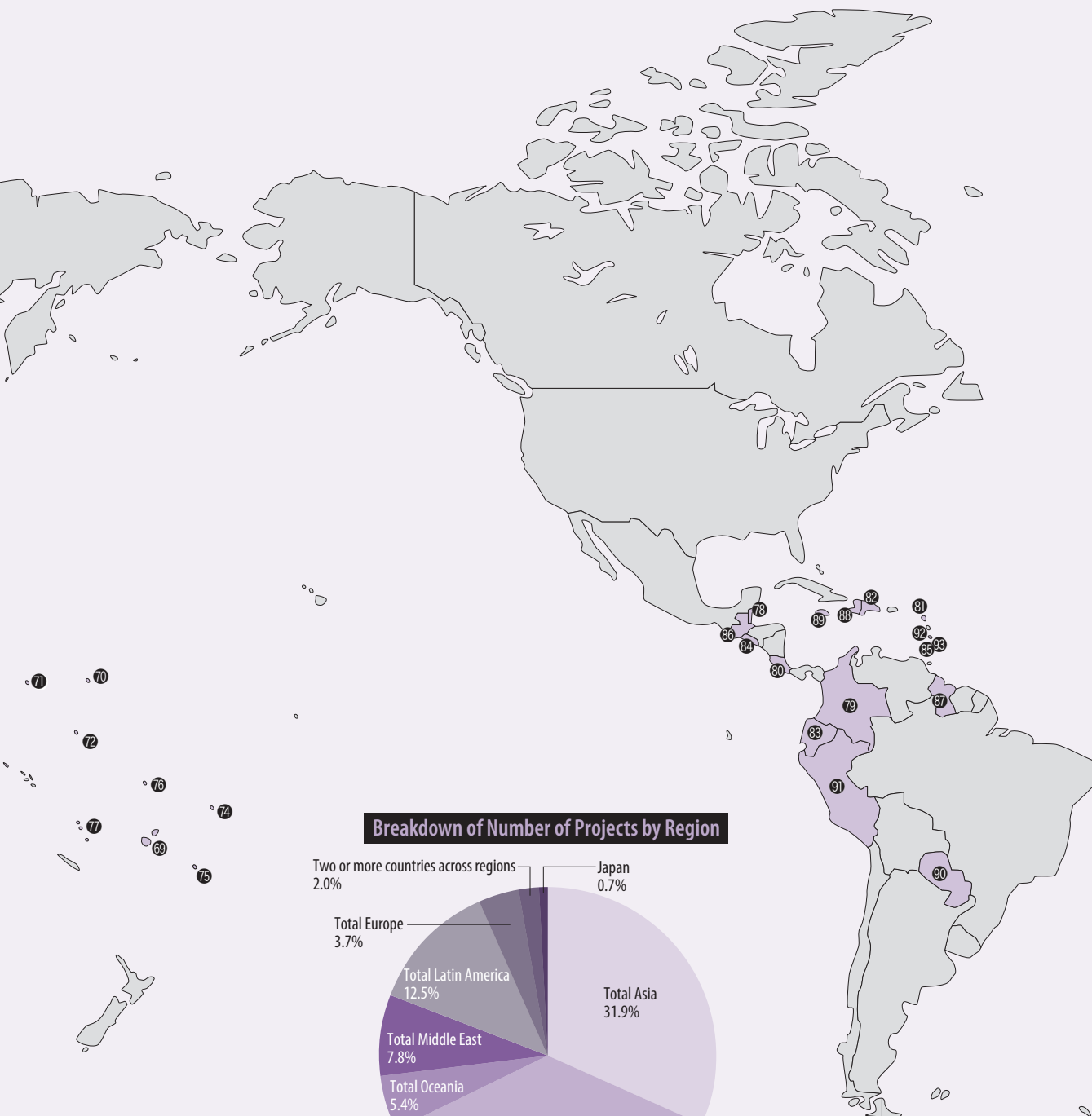

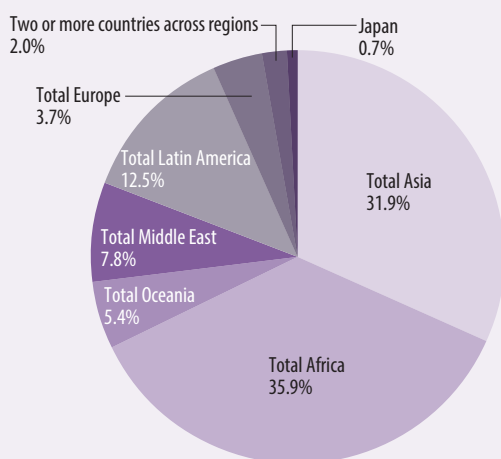

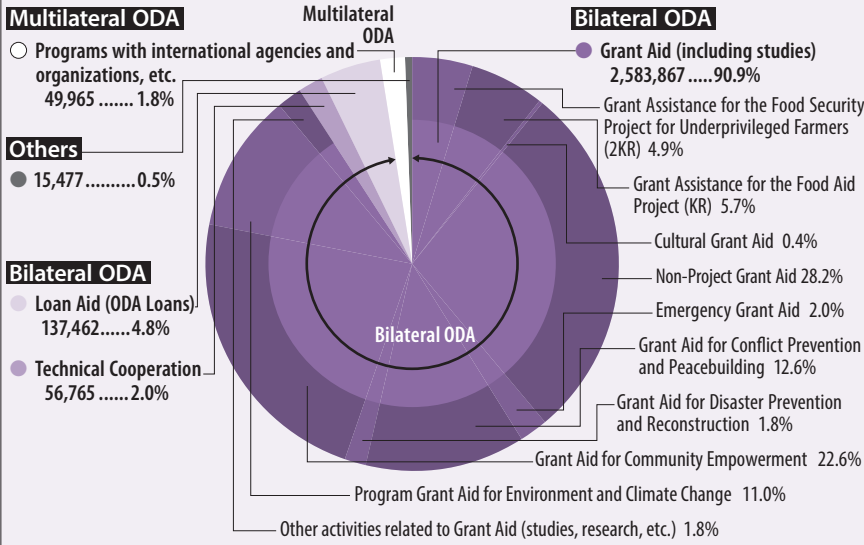

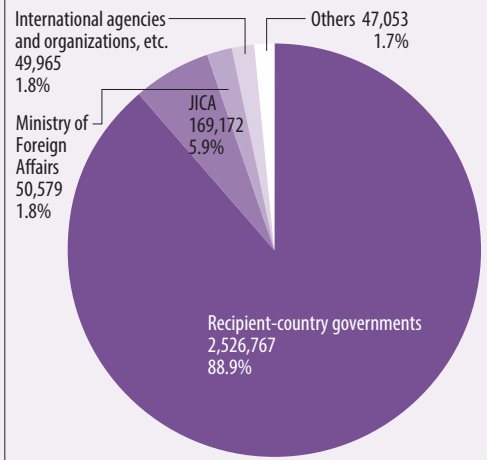
# Revenue/Current Profit by Scheme and Client (FY2014)

**Current Profit of Type of ODA (FY2014)** (Unit: thousand yen)

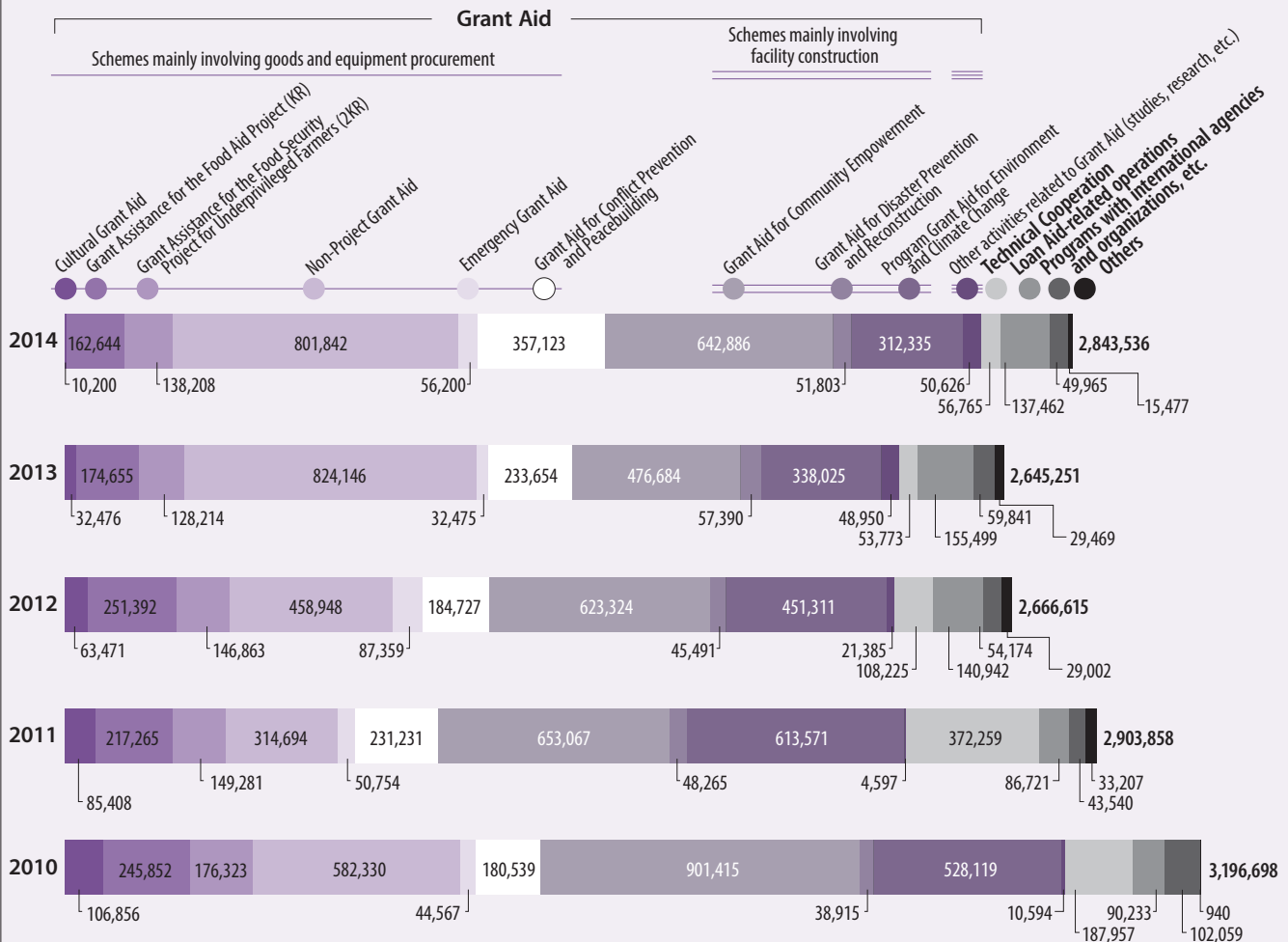


**Current Profit by Client (FY2014)** (Unit: thousand yen)

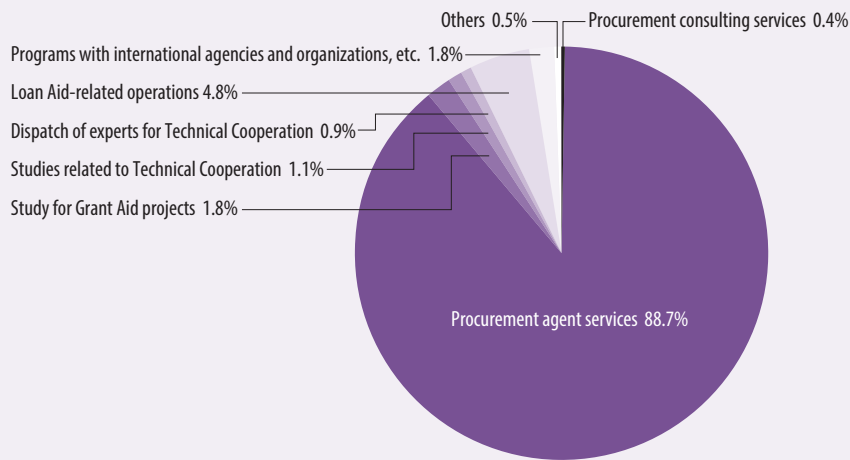
**Change in Revenue/Current Profit by Scheme (FY2010–2014)** (Unit: thousand yen)



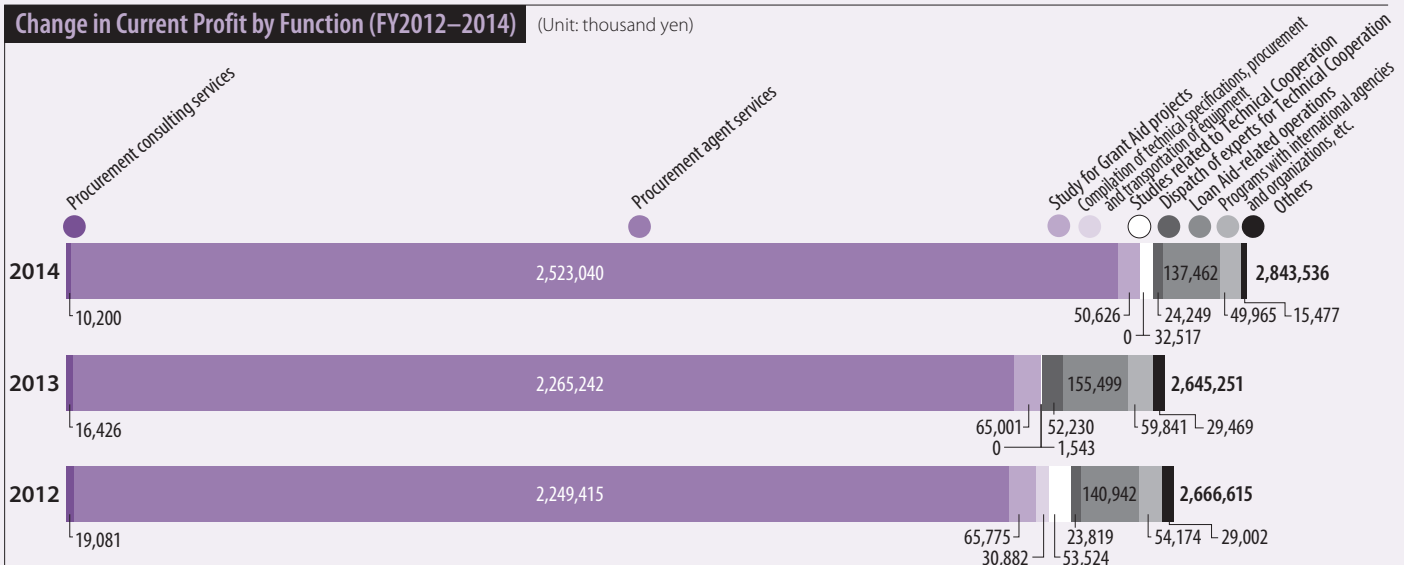
# Current Profit by Function (FY2014)

## Procurement consulting services

JICS provides a range of services—based on contracts with recipient-country governments—from the standpoint of acting to support the recipient-country government in its role as the main executing authority of a project. JICS manages the overall process for the procurement of goods and selection of services in relation to grant aid projects. This may include the preparation of tender documents, tender execution, expediting the signing of purchasing contracts and supervising the manufacture, transportation and delivery of materials and equipment by contractors. JICS carries out such procurement consulting services for Cultural Grant Aid. (As a matter of convenience, revenue from tender assistance work for Cultural Grant Aid is also included in this category.)

## Procurement agent services

JICS acts as a procurement agent of a recipient-country government, the main executing authority of a project, to procure necessary goods and equipment and to oversee facility construction for the execution of grant aid projects and other projects, primarily based on contracts with recipient-country governments. JICS provides administrative and project management services, which include the overall process for procurement (tender execution, conclusion of contracts for purchase and service, delivery and construction, etc.) as well as funds payment.

## Studies for Grant Aid projects

Based on contracts with such agencies as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan and JICA, JICS carries out analysis and screening of requests submitted to the Japanese government from recipient-country governments and other parties. Studies cover such aspects as validity of the request and examination of materials and equipment specifications and costs. JICS carries out screening of applications and reports for Grant Assistance for Japanese NGO Projects, compilation of sports equipment lists for Cultural Grant Aid, and studies of construction projects for Grant Aid projects through field investigations of construction work to study changes in the construction environment in the executing counterpart country.

## Studies related to Technical Cooperation

Based on contracts with JICA and other parties, JICS dispatches personnel and provides other services to support procurement related to Technical Cooperation projects.

## Dispatch of experts for Technical Cooperation

Based on contracts with JICA, as part of Technical Cooperation, JICS dispatches experts related to fields relevant to aid projects being executed by JICS.

## Loan Aid-related operations

Based on contracts with JICA (JBIC before October 2008), JICS carries out basic screening of the content of procurement-related documentation submitted by recipient-country governments to confirm whether or not such documentation complies with the loan program guidelines and other requirements. If this screening reveals any problems or points that require clarification, JICS reports to JICA on its findings. In addition to the abovementioned operations, JICS also carries out procurement operations as part of ODA Loan projects, Ex-Post Procurement Audits, the dispatch of experts for Loan Aid execution facilitation, and other services.

## Operations related to international agencies and organizations

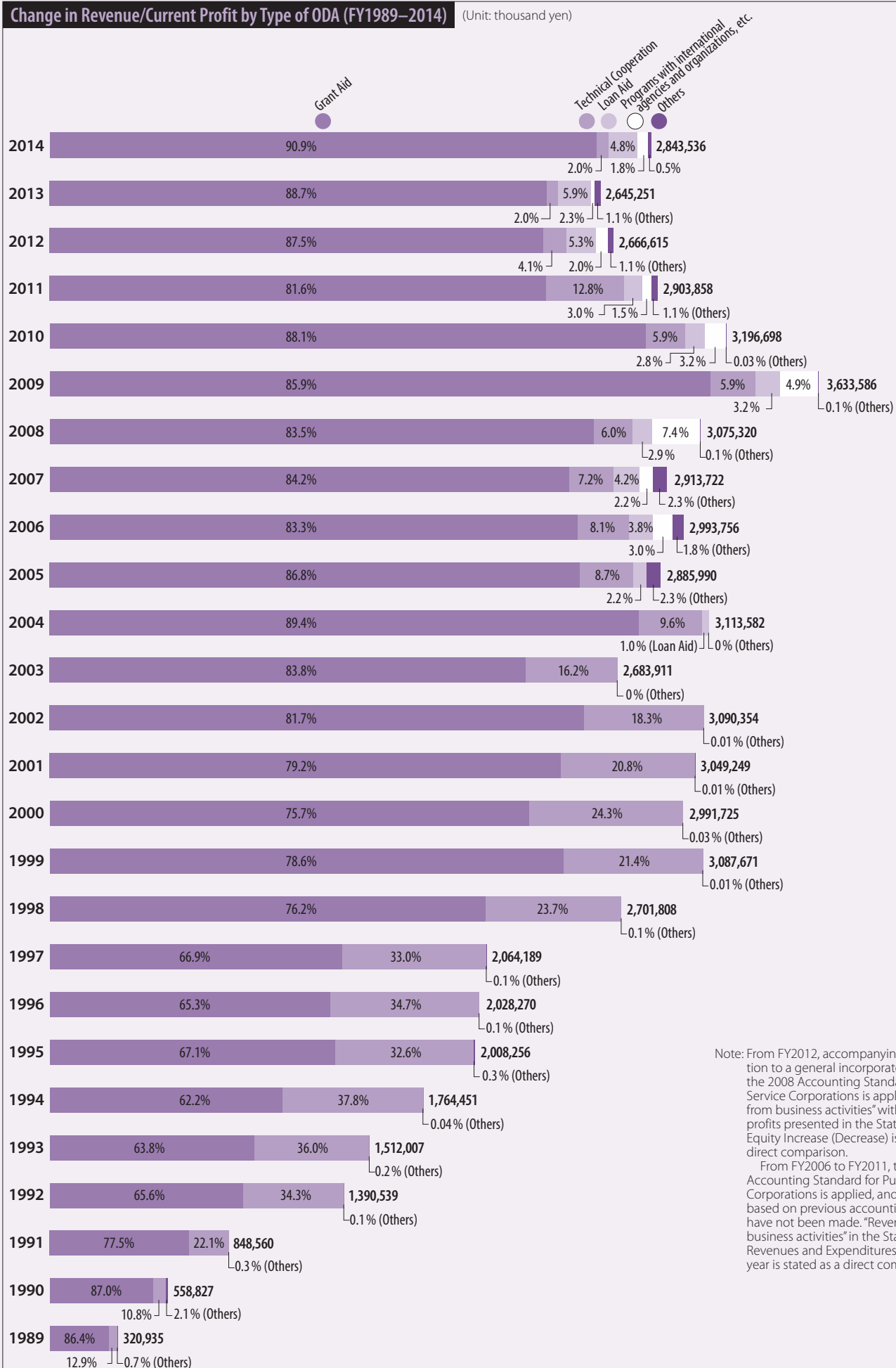
With regard to projects executed by international agencies and organizations, based on contracts with relevant agencies, JICS provides a range of services to meet specific project requirements. Such services include conducting studies, undertaking procurement operations in line with international rules, providing project implementation management services and reporting to and coordinating activities with international agencies and organizations.

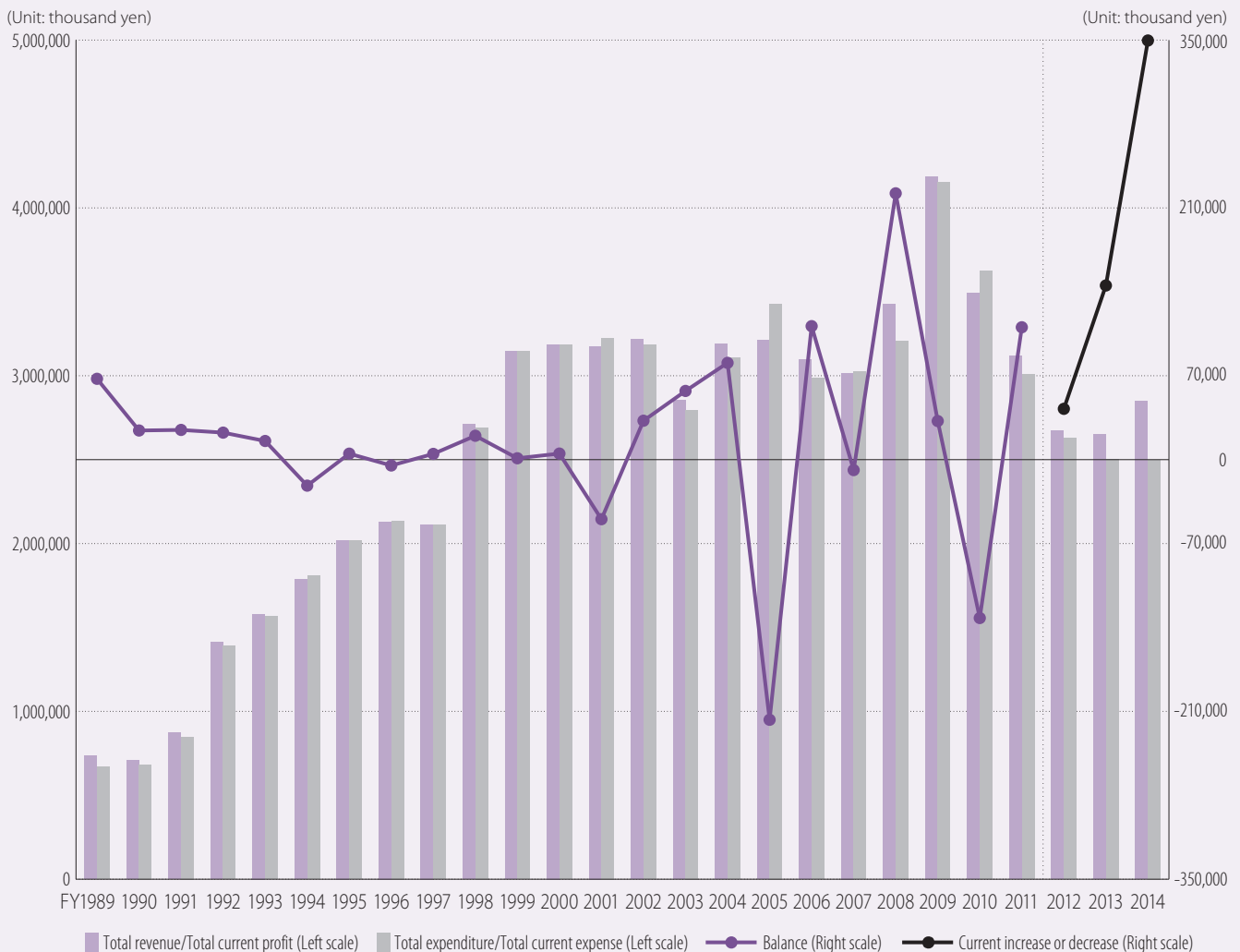
